

# Student jobs

Placement étudiant meets the student manpower needs of the Québec public service, private companies and municipalities. It operates in much the same way as any other job placement and employee recruitment service.

The Placement étudiant Web site provides access to the Online Placement service, which allows you to list your candidacies and consult offers for jobs and paid internships.

## Online Placement

By listing your student candidacies (i.e., summaries of your résumé), you offer your services to thousands of employers in the private sector and, at the same time, register with the bank of candidacies for Québec government jobs available year-round. You can work full-time during the summer and part-time, up to a maximum of 14 hours a week, during a school term. Online Placement allows you to consult offers for student jobs in the Québec public service. To obtain this type of employment, you have to list your student candidacies and make sure that they remain active.

Once they have been listed, your candidacies will also be available for consultation by all other employers. Thanks to Online Placement, you can also consult offers for jobs and paid internships that correspond to your profile. To avoid missing out on jobs and internships, consult Online Placement regularly. If you sign up for "Job Alerts!" you will receive e-mails, on a daily or weekly basis, notifying you of new offers that meet your criteria. Online Placement also allows you to access information about specific trades and occupations by clicking the LMI Online hyperlink.
